

Arrival at International Belgrade Airport Nikola Tesla:

- Upon your delegation's arrival at International Belgrade Airport Nikola Tesla, you will be welcomed by the LOC team. In the arrival hall there will be official event stand.
- A courteous team member will be there to guide you to the bus, which will be ready to transport your delegation to the designated hotel.

Transfer to Event Hotel:

- The bus will provide a comfortable journey to the hotel where your delegation will be accommodated for the duration of the Event.
- Upon arrival at the hotel, our staff will be on hand to assist with check-in and ensure your delegation settles in smoothly.

Special arrangement for Artistic Gymnastics:

• Since this competition takes place in the City of Novi Sad, all participants involved will travel directly from Belgrade Airport to Belgrade and will be accommodated there for the duration of the competition. The distance from Belgrade to Novi Sad is 45-60 minutes. After competition, they will join their national delegations in Zlatibor for the Cultural Day, Nations Night and Closing Ceremony where they will stay until the end of the event.

Accreditation Process for Delegations:

- The day following your arrival, we have arranged a special transport for the Head of Delegation to Accreditation centre.
- Once the accreditation is completed, the Head of Delegation will be promptly returned to their hotel.
- We kindly ask you to bring all passports and other relevant documents that are needed for the accreditation.
- Please note that all delegation that have not settled the payment of all costs (accommodation, ISF levy, ISF academy, missing referees) will not be able to participate in competition until all costs are settled.

- Throughout your stay, our team will be available to assist with any queries or requirements.
- We hope you find your accommodations comfortable and conducive to a successful championship experience.


TRANSPORTATION DETAILS



The transportation system for the ISF U15 Gymnasiade on Zlatibor will be well-organized to ensure smooth and efficient travel for all participants. **The main central bus station**, located near the Zlatibor gondola, will serve as the departure point for all athletes and teams traveling to sports venues outside Zlatibor.

For sports events taking place within Zlatibor, participants will be able to walk to their competition venues, as most of the facilities are within walking distance from the accommodation. Additionally, all non-sport activities, including the Opening Ceremony, ISF Academy seminars, Fun and Skill Zone, Nations Night, Cultural Day, and the Closing Ceremony, will be held within Zlatibor and will also be easily accessible on foot.

A detailed transportation schedule will soon be available online via a dedicated link, ensuring that all teams and officials have up-to-date information on departure times and routes.



EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

SAFEGUARDING IN SPORT: THE PREVENTION OF INTERPERSONAL VIOLENCE.

We believe that children have the inner resources if educated, to fully understand, identify and react in front of negative behavior such as racism, gender inequity or violence and abuse. The challenge for ISF is to find the right way to express difficult ideas and present complicated topics to young people in order for them, not only to understand but also to appropriately apprehend this issue and be able to react if facing it.

Creating awareness and giving the opportunity for the participants to able to transfer their knowledge when getting back home to their peers is also key to ISF.

The Safeguarding Workshop is designed with young athletes at its core, recognising their central role in the school sport ecosystem. ISF is dedicated to ensuring that all children experience sport participation free from any negative behaviours that could impact their wellbeing. This session of 30 minutes employs interactive and pedagogical methods to provide participants with a clear understanding of safeguarding issues in sport. It aims to teach youth athletes how to recognise interpersonal violence and react appropriately if it occurs to themselves or their peers. This workshop emphasizes that experiencing interpersonal violence is never the fault of the victim and that the development of a safe sport environment is crucial to provide the appropriate support and help when athletes seek it.

Anti-doping education goes beyond the realm of sports. It serves as a platform to impart valuable life lessons and cultivate ethical values in young individuals. By emphasizing the importance of honesty, integrity, and personal responsibility, anti-doping education contributes to the moral development of young athletes. It encourages them to make informed choices, stand up against cheating, and develop a strong sense of integrity that extends beyond the realm of sports and into other aspects of their lives. anti-doping education plays a crucial role in shaping the attitudes and behaviors of young people involved in sports. Educating them about the risks, consequences, and ethical implications of doping, promotes health, fair play, and integrity while providing them with the necessary tools to make informed decisions that align with their long-term well-being and athletic aspirations.

PREVENTION INJURY

Ilnjury Prevention - Basics to Specifics

Today's daily routines with long sitting hours, screen work and mobile devices in use all day long, posture and related pain syndromes become more and more important.

At the same time almost all international sport federations tend to start in younger ages with competition on continental and world level. Therefore, national federations, clubs and even schools started to focus on specific training mainly, basic education is mainly neglected due to a lack of time and very often due to a lack of interest of young athletes as training of basic abilities is considered less fun and quite often boring. A matter of presentation and wrapping from our point of view.

This workshop will focus on Injury Prevention with its various factors, the meaning of "the basics" such as mobility, flexibility and stability for both, injury prevention / health as well as performance and provide as well as best practice examples of how to implement Injury Prevention routines into daily sport routines at school or in clubs.

Based on our long-term experience in high performance sports from children to Olympic athlete level we are convinced that Injury Prevention, the work on the basic abilities and the specific training do not necessarily mean an "either or" but can go together very well, respecting practical limitations in time and by the number of educational needs in specifics and with some fun.

A couple of minutes only, integrated into warm-up and cool-down routines can make a significant difference in terms of overuse of structures and risks for injury for all age groups but in particular during the vulnerable period of growth.
